	8.2) it was reported that Cllr Gill Heath has been unwell and our requests for her assistance will have to wait until she is well again.
	8.3) Cllr Eddie Kidd proposed that a sign directing traffic to Gradbach should be erected past the old school as there are many cars taking the wrong turn at this point and causing a disturbance turning round and asking for directions. This was seconded by Cllr Andy Thorogood and unanimously agreed. The Clerk was requested to organise purchase of the sign.
Agenda item 9	Reporting of Highway Defects & other Parish Matters
Minute 21/01/11/09	9.1) Cllr. Andy Thorogood has installed anti-parking posts and reflective tape to try to prevent parking in the worst affected areas.
	9.2) As anticipated (refer to the minutes of the last meeting) the Cheshire Gritter lorry which needs to turn round in Gradbach was blocked by parking cars.
	9.3) A lorry delivering straw to the farm in Gradbach adjacent to Lud's Church was significantly delayed whilst local residents tracked down the drivers of parked cars blocking the roadway.
	9.4) It is proposed that tulip bulbs are planted on the roadside which may deter visitors from driving over the flowering plants to park.
	9.5) There is high probability of complete gridlock caused by visitors cars as soon as lockdown restrictions begin to be eased.

	This is because;
	9.5.1)The National Trust and English Heritage will keep all their gates closed because they cannot meet the Covid social distancing regulations inside their historic buildings.
	9.5.2) The Peak Park and other National Parks do not have gates that can be closed.
	9.5.3) The 9 million people who normally fly abroad for Easter Holidays will still be in the UK looking for somewhere to take themselves and their children who have been locked up for months. They need to come into rural areas, there is nowhere else to go, so they cannot be blamed for turning up in overwhelming numbers. This will be a problem throughout the Peak Park, other National Parks, AOONB and coastal resorts.
	9.6) Therefore Quarnford Parish Council requests that the Peak District National Park Authority immediately enter into dialogue with both 10 and 11 Downing Street to obtain funds

	to create the solution to this impending national disaster.
	9.6.1) The short term solution will mean designating parking areas by arrangements with local landowners and installing temporary toilet facilities such as are normally used for large scale outdoor events.
	9.6.2) These arrangements need to be planned now to be in place as lockdown restrictions begin to be lifted. Members of the public can be directed to these areas on national TV channels to make sure they go to the places that can accommodate the huge numbers who have to get out after lockdown.
	9.6.3) The people who will be needed as traffic marshals, security guards, catering staff etc can be signed up in the next few weeks and given training. Perhaps the people who have already been employed to assist with the 2021 Census can be given these different tasks to manage.
